## AYEN

Rosé Syrah/Malbec/Durif  
2016

Ayen "Laughter" in Mapudungun. Maipo Valley. Ayen is an early harvest wine. In these vineyards, whose setting is marked by forests and the maritime winds that come from the south, a fresh wine emerged, with great acidity and barrel-fermented to bring complexity and structure. Ayen is the perfect company for laughter and good times.

Fermented and aged in French oak barrels, fermentation at moderate temperatures (13-16 ° C), and, like Mako, sat on the lees to achieve greater volume in the mouth.

### VINEYARD PRODUCTION:

• 4 – 6 ton/ha.

### ANALYSIS:

- Alcohol: 13 %
- Total Acidity: 6 g/l
- pH: 3,27
- Residual Sugar: 2,23 g/l

Serving Temperature: Serve between 6 – 8 ° C.

The complex nose shows aromas of rose and cherry, and buttery notes. This is elegant wine on the palate, showing freshness and volume with a long and refined finish.
